
Film upload tutorial

DASHBOARD

After logging in, you'll be redirected to your Dashboard, aka your workspace.

This is where you can start uploading your film via „Upload Film“. The entire upload process consists of several straightforward steps and might take up to several hours.

Click on **Upload film** and continue.

Start by searching for your Film Title
We will start by searching for your film details in public databases. This will help us to fill in all the key information. If no source is found, you will be able to add the details into our database manually.

In case you cannot find your film, try to type in another name under which it has been released.

Still can't find your film? **Input your film details manually.** The details will be reviewed by one of our operators before you'll be able to proceed. Normally, this process takes around 24h.



Select the film file from your local disk

It is recommended to check that the uploaded film has the necessary quality and that your Internet connection is high speed with a minimum 2 Mbit/s. This is necessary so that the film so the film upload is sufficiently fast and there are no risks of interruptions. After selecting the film, please do not close the browser. The upload process can take a few hours based on the size of the film and the quality of the Internet connection.

Uploading formats

Video

- (lossless or using common codecs)
- Full HD, 2K or 4K
- MP4, AVI, MOV

Audio

- stereo sound or 5.1 sound (AC3 codec, i.e. channel order L, R, C, LFE, LS, RS)
- it is important to be in a single stream
- every language available needs to be in its own audio stream
- multiple audio streams (for multiple languages) are supported
- e.g. 5.1 mix in single stream and stereo downmix in single stream

Subtitles


- In a video container or added separately in step 6 or after the film activation
- make sure that the subtitles are in sync with the picture and sound

Upload the actual video container to the Artinii system. This might take minutes or hours, depending on your internet connection.

PROCESSING




When you select and confirm your film file in your browser, the upload process starts.

After the film file has been uploaded, the film will be automatically processed. This may take up to several hours.

If you close this browser window, you can finish the upload process later after visiting the **"My films"** section and switching to the film detail.

Once the processing is completed, your next step will be to check and tag the audio track(s) and subtitles.

REVIEW THE FILM DETAILS




The last step before an activation is the review of the film detail.

You can also review the Terms and Conditions. After you click on Confirm, the upload process will be complete and the film will be ready for review by Artinii.

Information about the film (title atd.) can be edited after the film activation.

To finish the **upload process**, click on the **Confirm button**.




READY FOR ACTION



You can now send films to users **who have an account with us and have set up a screening place** (this is set up in the user's dashboard on artinii.com).




You can assign the film to one of the **Distribution Platforms** you've been invited to.




The Marketplace is **where licenses for public screenings are sold**. The films are either managed by us, or by the rights-holders themselves.




Click on the film in **My films** to open the film detail.


