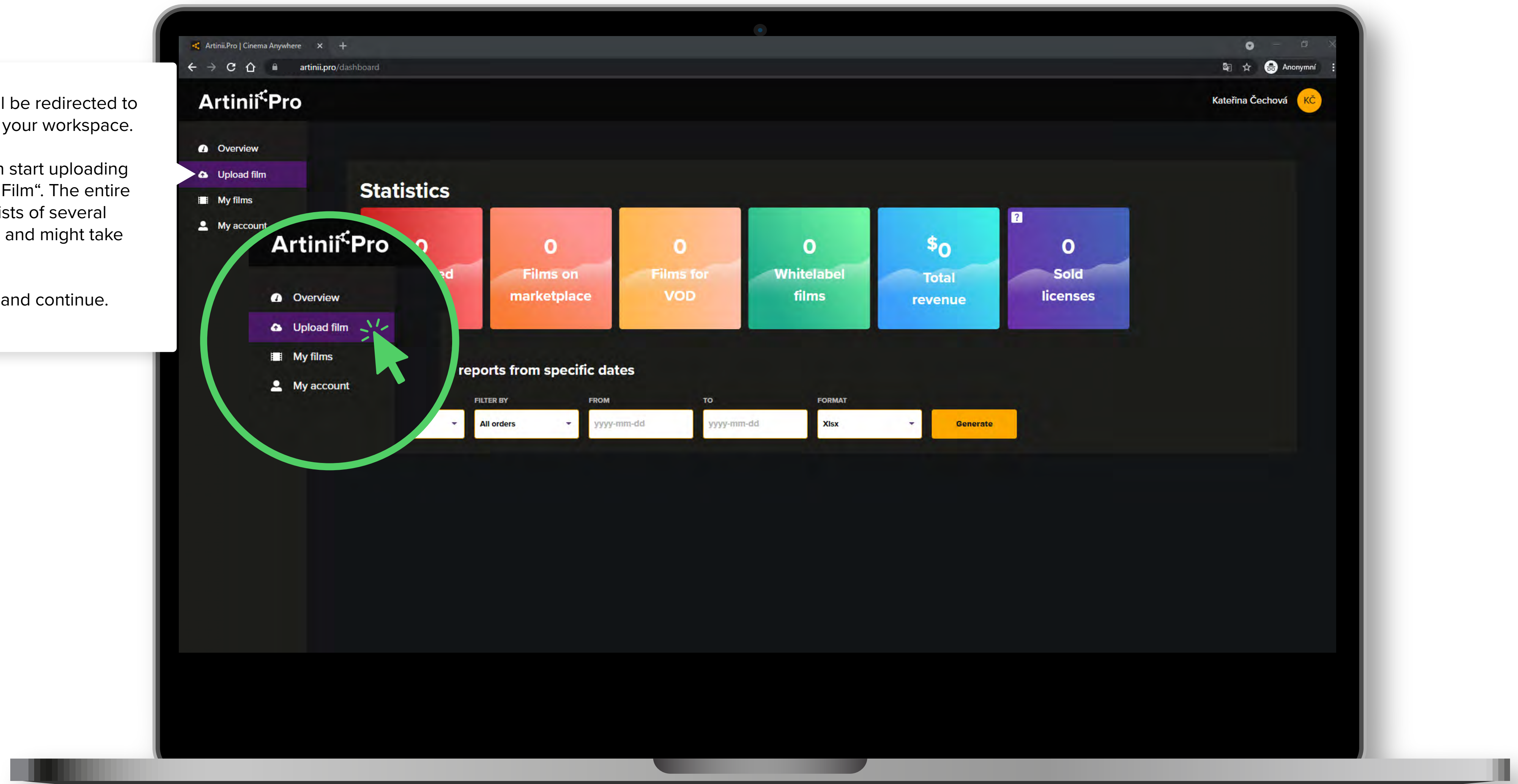
FILM UPLOAD TUTORIAL

DASHBOARD

After logging in, you'll be redirected to your Dashboard, aka your workspace.

This is where you can start uploading your film via „Upload Film“. The entire upload process consists of several straightforward steps and might take up to several hours.

16. OTHER PROVISIONS

16.1. ARTinii is not bound by any codes of conduct within the meaning of §1826 para. e) of the Civil Code.

16.2. You assume the risk of a change of circumstances in the sense of § 1765 para. 2 of the Civil Code. You do not have the rights that would flow to you from the provisions on disproportionate shortening according to the provisions of §1793 to §1795 of the Civil Code.

16.3. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is or becomes invalid or ineffective, the invalid provision will be replaced by a provision whose meaning is as close as possible to the invalid provision. The invalidity or ineffectiveness of one provision shall not affect the validity of the other provisions.

An expression permitting a different interpretation used for the first time by either contracting party cannot be interpreted to the detriment of that contracting party unless the other contracting party drew attention to a possible different interpretation at the hearing and the first contracting party nevertheless insisted on its use.

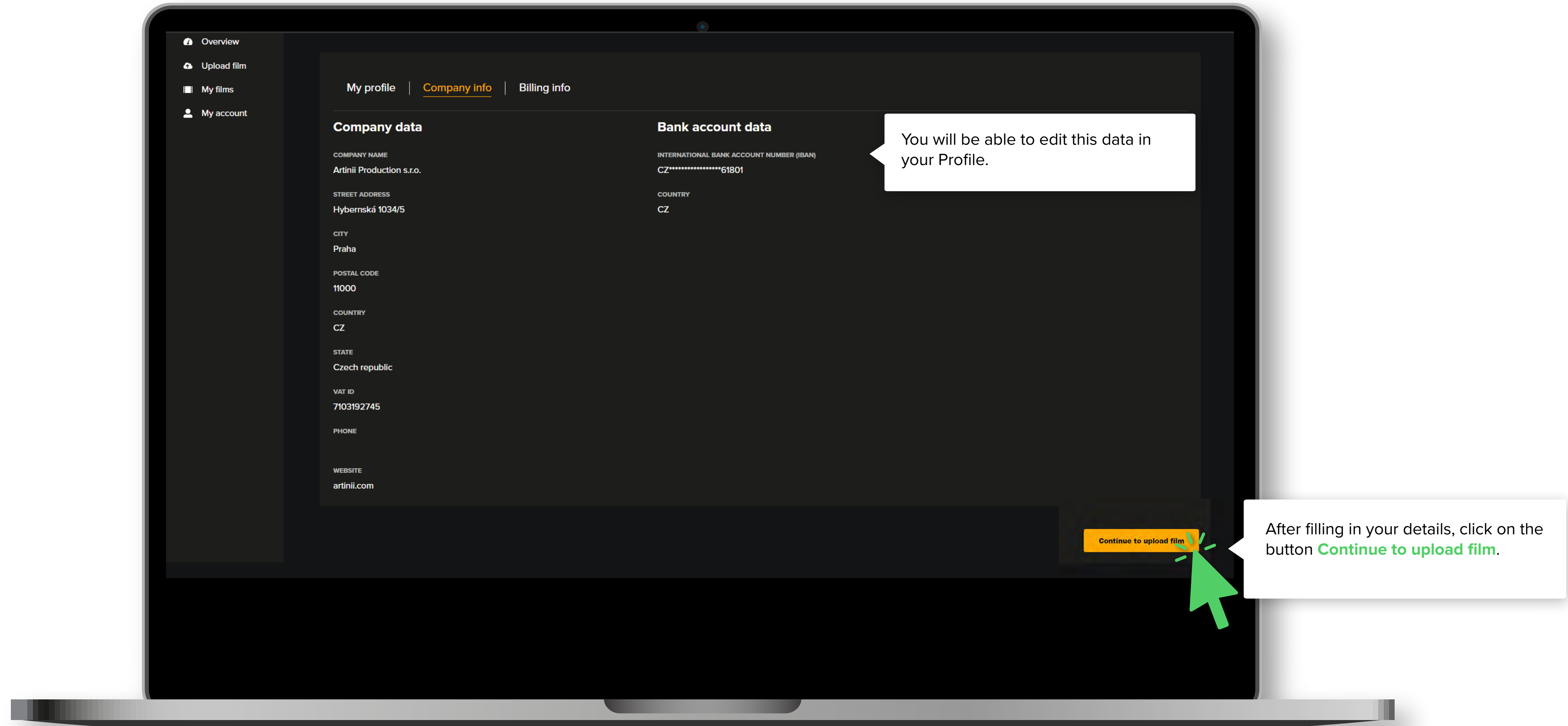

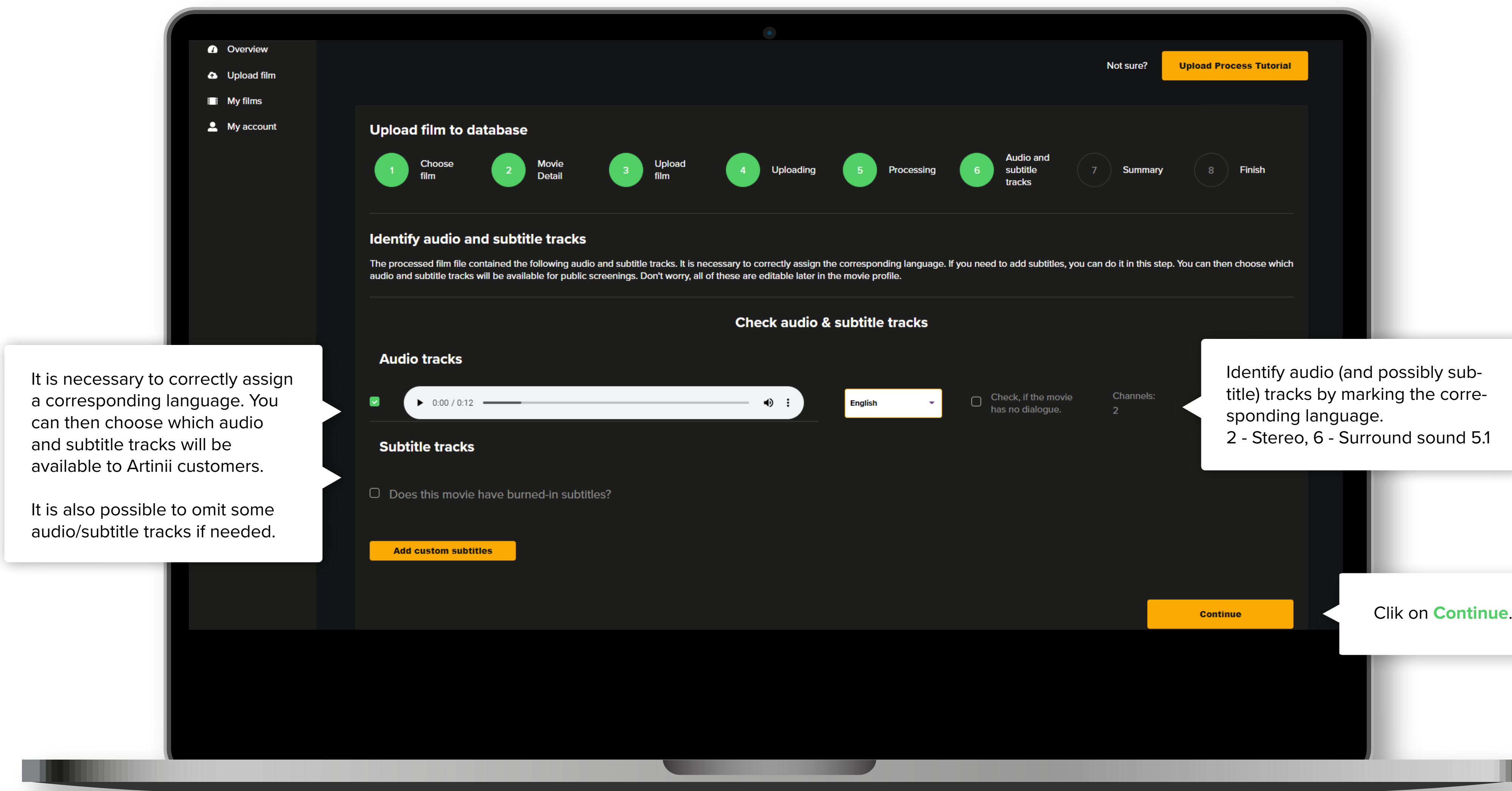
When you select and confirm your film file in your browser, the upload process starts.

After the film file has been uploaded, the film will be automatically processed. This may take up to several hours.

If you close this browser window, you can finish the upload process later after visiting the “**My films**” section and switching to the film detail.

Once the processing is completed, your next step will be to check and tag the audio track(s) and subtitles.

IDENTIFY AUDIO AND SUBTITLE TRACKS



It is necessary to correctly assign a corresponding language. You can then choose which audio and subtitle tracks will be available to Artinii customers.

It is also possible to omit some audio/subtitle tracks if needed.

Identify audio (and possibly subtitle) tracks by marking the corresponding language.

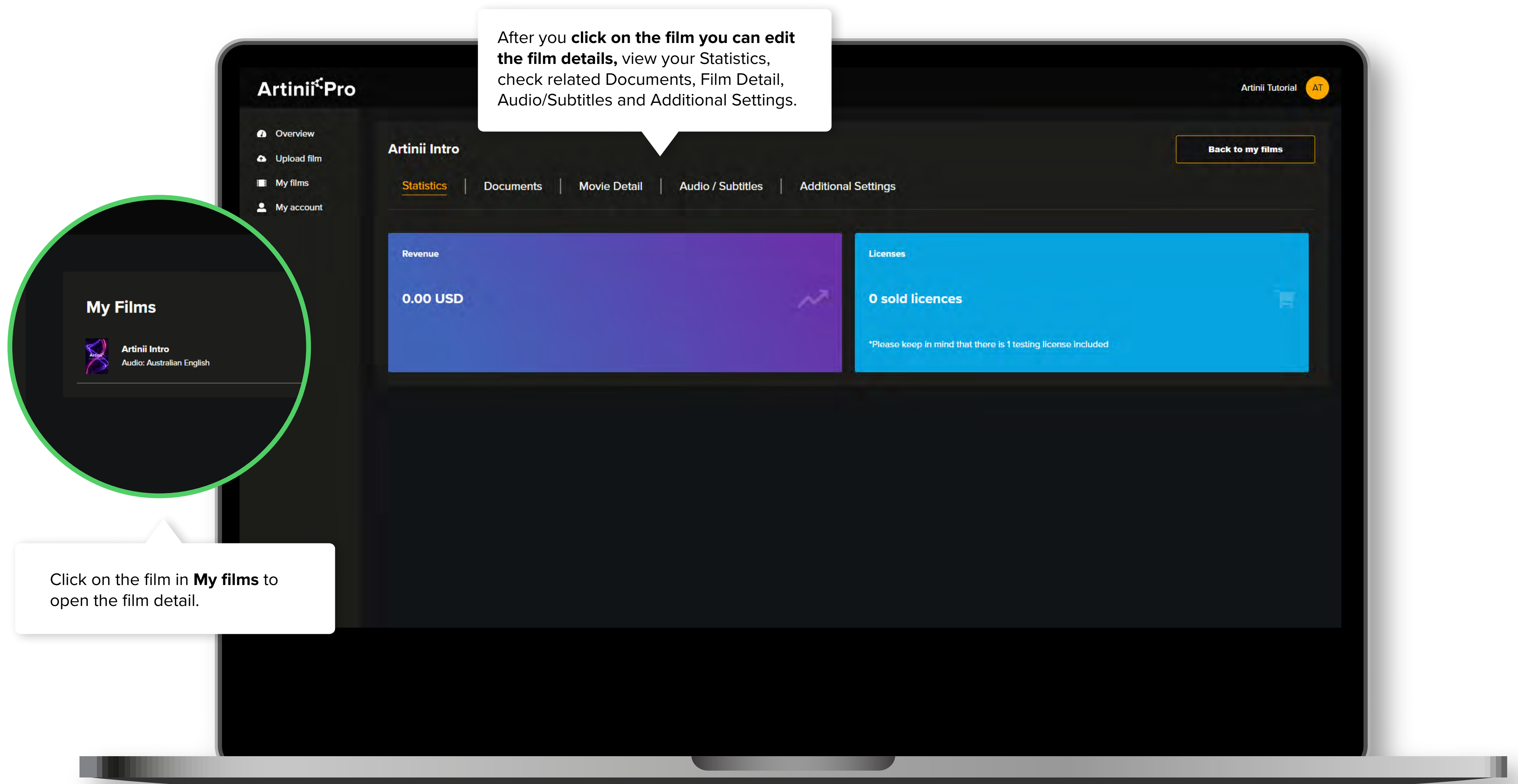


You can now send films to users **who have an account with us** and **have set up a screening place** (*this is set up in the user's dashboard on artinii.com*).

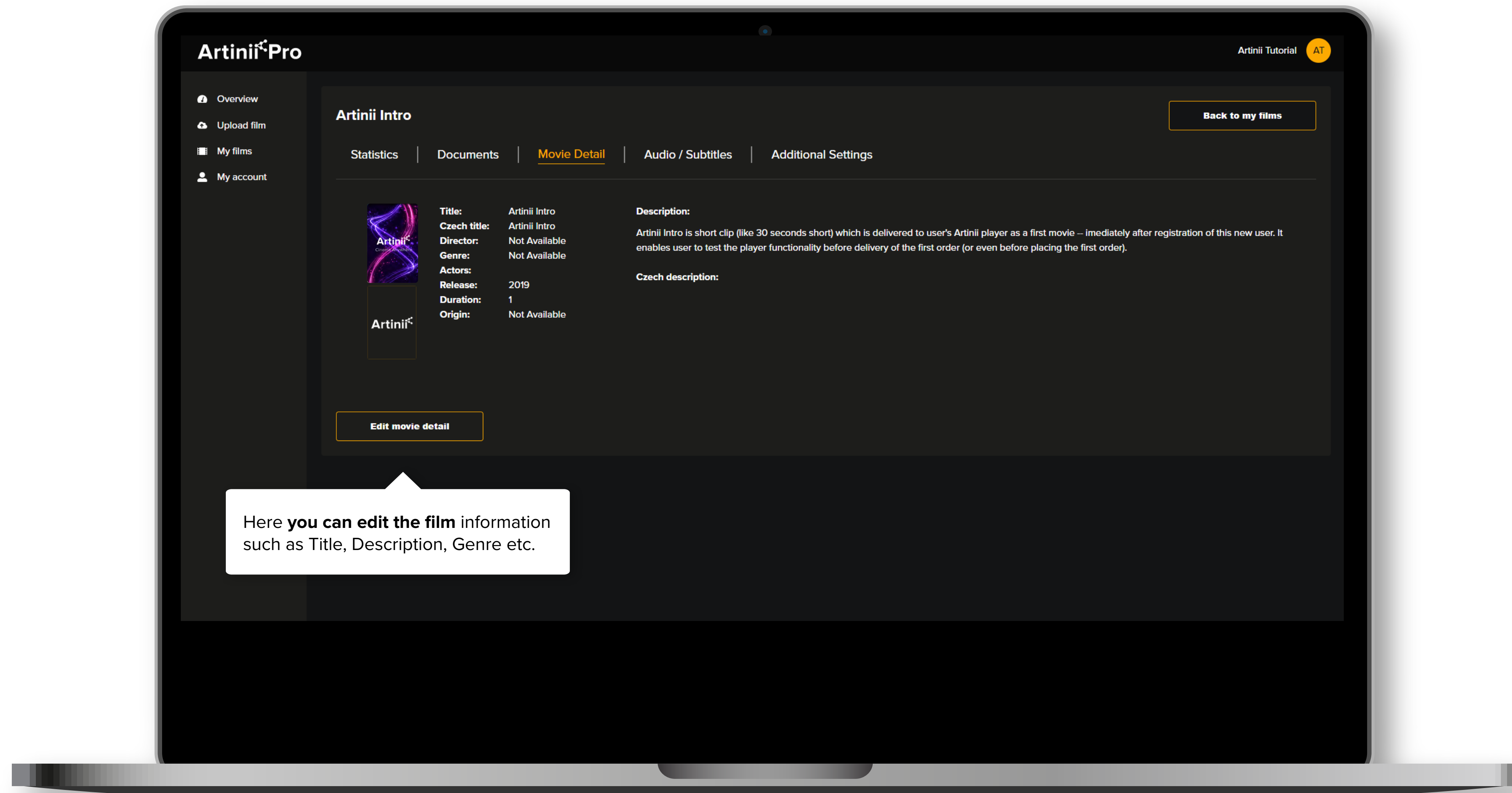
You can assign the film to one of the **Distribution Platforms** you've been invited to.

The Marketplace is **where licenses for public screenings are sold**. The films are either managed by us, or by the rights-holders themselves.

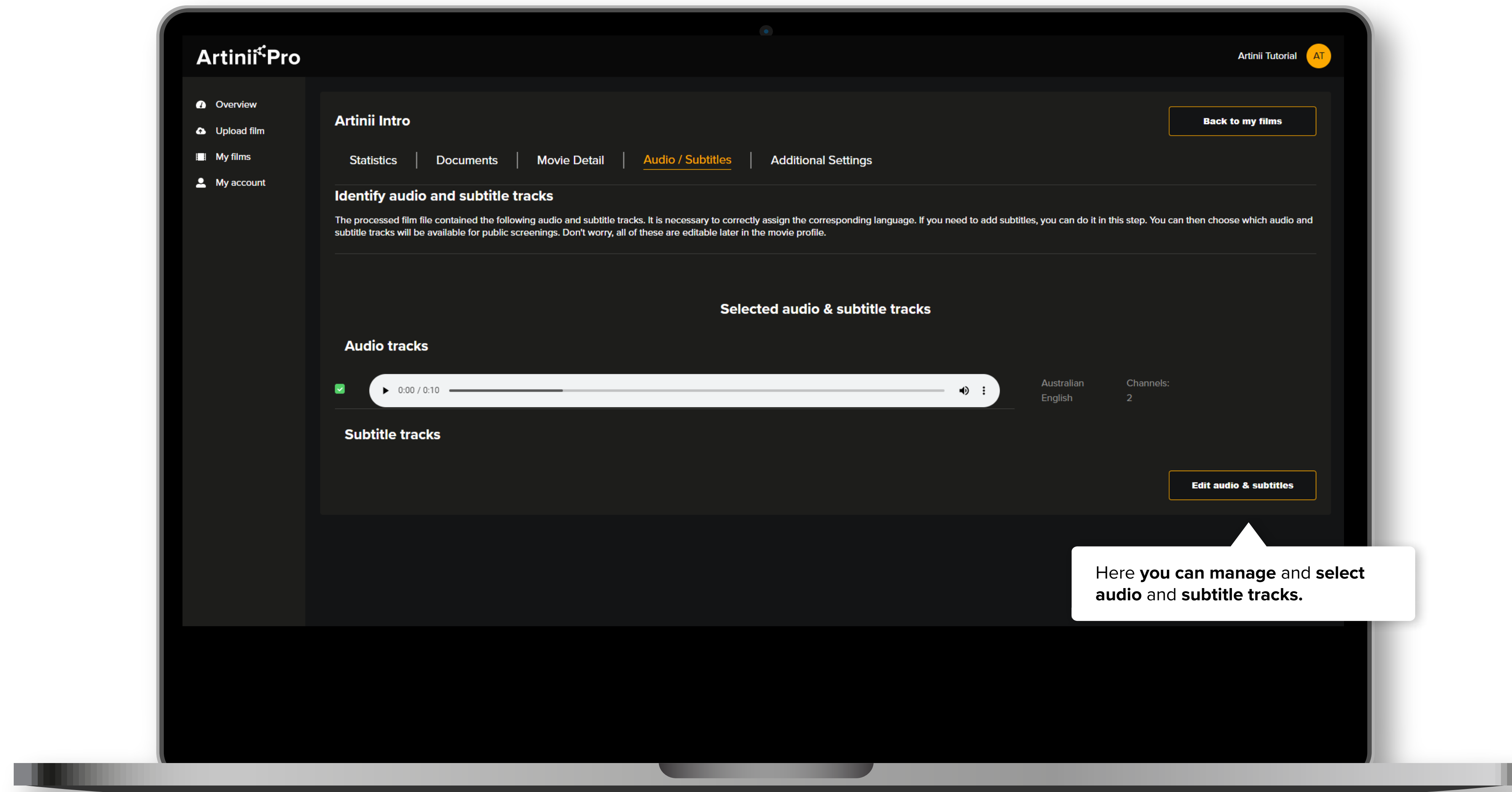

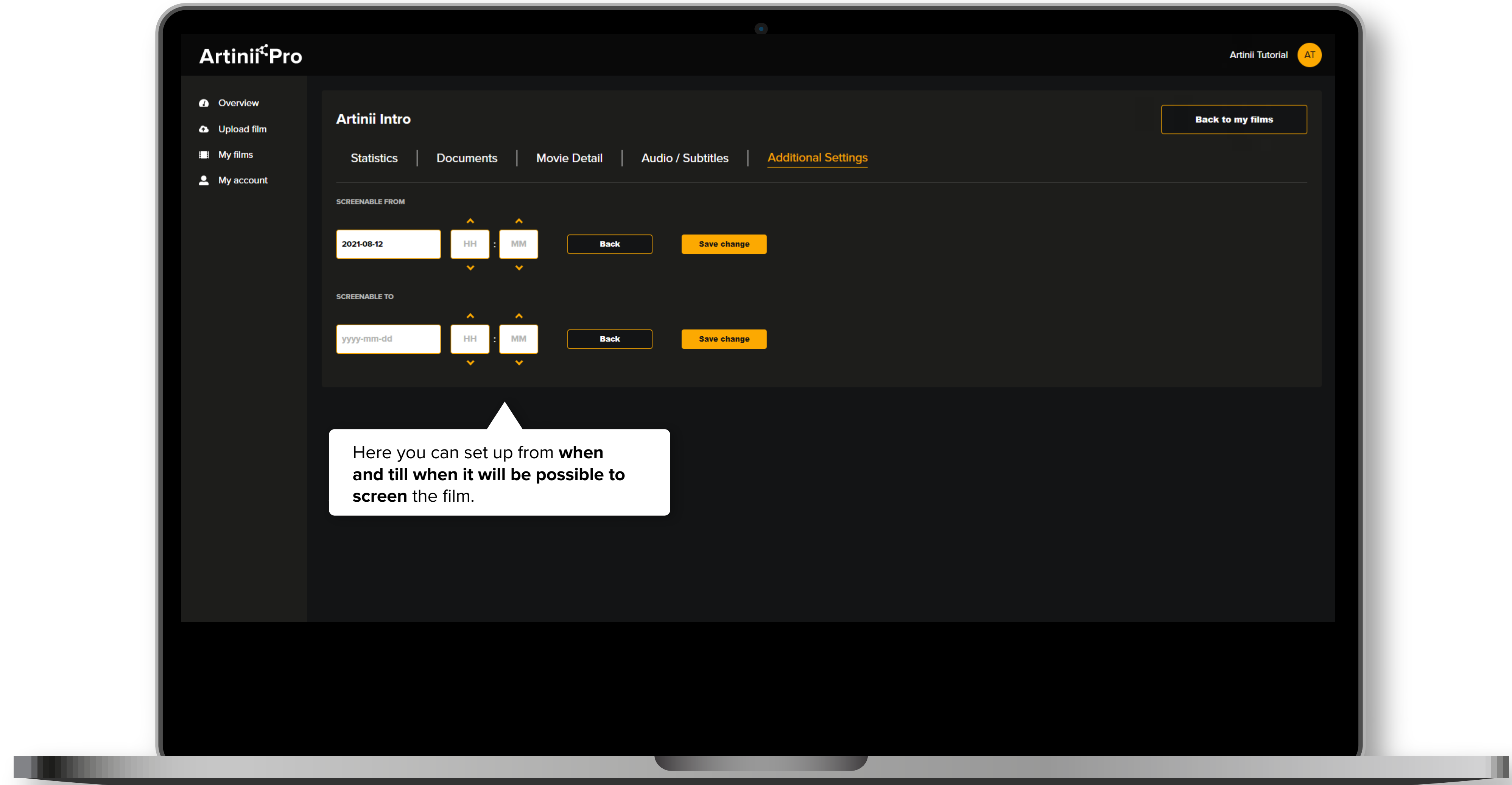
